



Cilvēki laivās. Alberts Bels

Tas aicina domāt par to, kā mazai tautai izdzīvot starp lielajām un vai ir iespējama vienošanās, ja katram savā taisnība šķiet vienīgā pareizā


Dzejnieks Nujorkā. Federiko Garsija Lorka

Grāmatā ietvertas divas biogrāfisko avotu publikācijas – viens brālis rakstīja atmiņas, otrs piezīmes un dienasgrāmatu. Abi brāļi Otrā pasaules kara laikā nonāca pretinieku armiju rindās, vēlāk viena dzīve norisinājās padomju Latvijā, otram – Lielbritānijā. Viens brālis bija jūrnieks un iekļuva Sarkanās armijas rindās, bet otrs brālis – nonāca leģionā. Brāļi pēdējo reizi tiekas 1941. gada sākumā un tad – neilgi pirms Kārla nāves Lielbritānijā 2000. gadā

Izcilais vācu filozofs Frīdrihs Nīče (1844–1900) ir viens no galvenajiem modernisma laikmeta domātājiem. Viņš savos darbos risinājis fundamentālus dzīves un filozofijas jautājumus. Nīčes idejas ir būtiski ietekmējušas turpmāko gadsimtu kultūru, filozofiju un mākslu. "Ecce homo" (1888) ir pēdējais Nīčes sarakstītais darbs. Tajā Nīče aplūko savu dzīvi un darbus, izvērtēdams savus filozofiskos uzskatus un to nozīmīgumu. "Ecce homo" ir uzskatāms par Nīčes garīgo testamentu



Mācīties dejot lietū. Kornēlijā Faulde

Dzīve bez robežām. Pārvarot cilvēcisko nolemtību. Maikls A. Zingers



Neatliekamās palīdzības dienesti



Lewis Hamilto (Little People, BIG DREAMS)



I Follow The Fox by Rob Biddulph



InvestiGATORS: All Tide Up by John Patrick Green




The Puppets of Spelhorst by Kate DiCamillo


Finding Bear by Hannah Gold

Sunrise on the Reaping (The Hunger Games) by Suzanne Collins



Games Untold by Jennifer Lynn Barnes


Book 5 of 6: The Inheritance Games


Greek Lessons by Han Kang


In Ascension by Martin MacInnes


The Crash by Freida McFadden


The Housemaid Is Watching by Freida McFadden
